STIPULATION

This matter is scheduled for hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules on January 13, 2009, pursuant to a Formal Complaint ("Complaint") filed in accordance with the provisions of the Michigan Occupational Code ("Code"), 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.101 *et seq.*, against Heritage Craftsmen LLC, Brent Alexander Ahmkasaube, Qualifying Officer ("Respondent"), by the Department of Energy, Labor & Economic Growth, Bureau of Commercial Services ("Bureau"). The parties wish to reach an amicable settlement of the Complaint; therefore:

1. **IT IS STIPULATED** by the parties that Respondent admits to the allegations set forth in paragraphs 1 through 14 of the Complaint.

2. **IT IS STIPULATED** by the parties that Respondent admits to violating sections 604(c) and 2411(2)(d),(e) and (j) of the Michigan Occupational Code; 1980 PA 299; as amended, MCL 339.604 (c), and MCL 339.2411(2)(d),(e) & (j) and 1979 AC, R 338.1933(3) and R338.1536.

3. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto that Heritage Craftsman, LLC and Brent Alexander Ahmkaube, Q.O. shall be placed on PROBATION for two years.

4. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that Respondent shall pay a FINE in the amount of TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS. The fine shall be paid by cashier's check or money order, with Complaint No. 306457 clearly indicated on the check or money order, made payable to the State of Michigan, within sixty (60) days of the date of mailing of the Final Order in this matter. The check or money order shall be mailed to the Department of Energy, Labor & Economic Growth, Bureau of Commercial Services, Administrative Services Division, P.O. Box 30018, Lansing, Michigan 48909. Respondent's failure pay the fine within six months of the date of the Board's Order shall result in a suspension of all licenses or registrations held by Respondent, the denial of any license or registration renewal applied for by Respondent, and the denial of future applications for licensure or registration applied for by Respondent until Respondent complies with the terms of this Stipulation.


5. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED** by and between the parties that Respondent's license shall be suspended for a minimum of one day and shall remain suspended until the fine is paid. Respondent's license will be revoked six months after the Board issues its Final Order if Respondent has not paid the fine.

6. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED** by the parties that the Legal Affairs Division Director of the Bureau, or the Director's designee, must approve this Stipulation before it is submitted to the Board for final approval. Should the Legal Affairs Division Director, the Director's designee,

or the Board reject this Stipulation, the Bureau will schedule a contested case hearing in this matter without prejudice to either party.

7. Respondent understands and intends that, by signing this Stipulation, Respondent is waiving the right, pursuant to the Occupational Code, supra, the rules promulgated thereto, and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 et seq., to a hearing before an administrative law judge, at which the Bureau would be required to prove the charges set forth in the Complaint by presentation of evidence and legal authority and at which Respondent would be entitled to appear with or without an attorney to cross-examine all witnesses presented by the Bureau and to present such testimony or other evidence or legal authority deemed appropriate as a defense to said charges.


