STIPULATION

This matter having been scheduled for a Compliance Conference in OKEMOS, Michigan, before the Department of Labor & Economic Growth, Bureau of Commercial Services, pursuant to an Administrative Complaint, hereafter "Complaint," dated **April 14, 2003**, filed in accordance with the provisions of the Michigan Occupational Code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.101 et seq., against ERIC J. JAWORSKI D/B/A NORTHWOOD CONTRACTORS, Respondent, hereafter "Respondent," by the Department of Labor & Economic Growth.

The Compliance Conference was originally scheduled on **August 5, 2004**, but was adjourned at Respondent's request. All parties being desirous of reaching an amicable settlement of said Complaint; hereby agree to the following:

1. **IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that Respondent admits to the factual allegations and violations set forth in numbered paragraph(s) of the Formal Complaint in this matter as follows:

6. Respondent's conduct in engaging in three incidents of larceny by conversion demonstrates his inability to serve the public in a fair, open and honest manner and his lack of good moral character, contrary to MCL 339.604(d).
7. Respondent's conduct in engaging in three incidents of Larceny by Conversation is conduct that is fraudulent, deceitful or dishonest within the meaning of 604(b) of the Occupational Code, contrary to MCL 339.604(b).

8. Respondent failed to respond to the Complaint in a timely manner, contrary to 1979 AC, R 338.1551(2).

9. Respondent has violated a rule of conduct in practicing an occupation, contrary to MCL 339.604(c).

2. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that Respondent shall pay a FINE in the amount of **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)**. Said fine shall be paid by cashier's check or money order, with Complaint No. **85564** clearly indicated on the check or money order, made payable to the State of Michigan, within sixty (60) days of the date of mailing of the Final Order in this matter. Said check or money order shall be mailed to the Department of Labor & Economic Growth, Bureau of Commercial Services, P.O. Box 30018, Lansing, Michigan 48909.

3. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that Respondent's Residential Builders License 21-01-043768 shall be **IMMEDIATELY REVOKED** on the date of mailing of the Final Order in this matter. Respondent shall immediately return any and all pocket or wall licenses to the address listed in Paragraph 5 below.

4. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that failure to comply with the terms set forth in this Stipulation shall result in a revocation or continued revocation of all licenses or registrations of Respondent or in the denial of any license or registration renewal and the denial of future applications for licensure or registration until compliance is made with the terms of this Stipulation.


5. Respondent agrees to submit written proof of having complied with each requirement of this Final Order, in a form acceptable to the Department, to the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth, Bureau of Commercial Services, Administrative Services Division, P.O. Box 30018, Lansing, MI 48909.

6. **IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED**, by and between the parties hereto, that the Director of the Legal Affairs Division of the Bureau of Commercial Services, or designee, must approve this Stipulation before it is submitted to the Board for final approval. Should the Legal Affairs

Division Director, or that person's designee, or the Board reject this Stipulation, the Department will schedule a contested case hearing in this matter without prejudice to either party.

7. Respondent understands and intends that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent is waiving the right, pursuant to the Occupational Code, supra, the rules promulgated thereto, and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 et seq., to a hearing before an administrative law judge, at which the Department would be required to prove the charges set forth in the Complaint by presentation of evidence and legal authority and at which Respondent would be entitled to appear with or without an attorney to cross-examine all witnesses presented by the Department and to present such testimony or other evidence or legal authority deemed appropriate as a defense to said charges.


