- Regarding company applicant ownership:
  - The applicant for auctioneer registration is the company. The auctioneer company is required to name one of the officers, partners, members or managing agents as the Qualifying Member, per Section 2905(2). It is intended that the Qualifying Member complete the application for the company registration.
  - The Qualifying Member must hold a current auctioneer registration in Michigan. If the Qualifying Member is not currently registered, form BCS/AUC-001 is required to be completed and filed.
  - Check the company structure below:
    - Partnership** - If the applicant company is a Partnership, one of the partners must be the Qualifying Member. The Certificate of Co-Partnership as filed with the county clerk's office in the county in which the auctioneer company intends to operate must be submitted with this application.
    - Limited Liability Company** - If the applicant company is a Limited Liability Company, one of the members of the LLC must be the Qualifying Member. The Department will verify that the company is current and will review the Articles of Organization as filed with the Corporation Division, as well as verify that if the LLC is using an Assumed Name, that the appropriate document is also filed with the Corporation Division.
    - Corporation** - If the applicant company is a Corporation, one of the officers must be the Qualifying Member. The Department will verify that the company is current and will review the Articles of Incorporation as filed with the Corporation Division, as well as verify that if the Corporation is using an Assumed Name, that the appropriate document is filed with the Corporation Division.
- All registrations expire September 30 of odd-numbered years.
