APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MAY 6, 2008

PETITIONS

LOREN IRVING MILLER

The Board received a petition for review from Loren Irving Miller requesting that correspondence and other information he has provided be accepted as proof that he has complied with the Final Order issued by Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors Board for Complaint Number 21-0800-82 (12384). Mr. Miller addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Mr. August and supported by Mr. Haeussler that after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board agreed to accept the information provided as acceptable proof that the repairs had been completed in order to satisfy the Final Order. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

KEVIN PETER OLENDER

The Board received a petition for review of the Department's denial of an individual residential builder license application received December 12, 2007. The Department denied the license on the basis of a lack of good moral character as evidenced by a relevant criminal conviction history report. Mr. Olender, along with his Attorney Patrick McFadden, addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Ms. Lane and supported by Mr. August that, after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board moved to table consideration of the petition to the meeting of September 9, 2008 in order to provide the petitioner an opportunity to submit additional material in support of his petition. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

MICHAEL ERNEST SEXTON (MIKE'S REMODELING & REPAIR LLC)

The Board received a petition for review of the Department's denial of a limited liability company residential builder license application received November 7, 2007. The Department denied the

license on the basis of a lack of good moral character as evidenced by a relevant criminal conviction history report. Mr. Sexton addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Ms. Lane and supported by Mr. Haeussler that, after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board upheld the Department's denial on the basis that (1) although the denial was not based upon the convictions alone, the criminal offenses were reasonably related to the practice of residential building, (2) sufficient evidence/length of rehabilitation was not presented, and (3) the consequences and nature of the offense distinctly bear upon the ability of a licensee to deal in an open, honest, and fair manner with the public. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

DAVID A SOSNOWSKI

The Board received a petition for review of the Department's denial of an individual residential builder relicensure application received February 12, 2008. The Department denied the license on the basis that he has not complied with a Final Order issued on January 24, 2002 by the Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors Board. Mr. Sosnowski addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Ms. Lane and supported by Mr. DiStefano that, after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board upheld the Department's denial on the basis that Mr. Sosnowski has not complied with the Final Order issued by the Board. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

MARCUS W. YONO

The Board received a petition for review of the Department's denial of an individual residential builder license application received April 9, 2008. The Department denied the license on the basis of a lack of financial stability, as evidenced by a recent credit report. Mr. Yono addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Ms. Lane and supported by Mr. Haeussler that, after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board moved to table consideration of the petition to the meeting of November 18, 2008 in order to provide the petitioner an opportunity to submit additional material in support of his petition. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

TIMOTHY BROOKS POWELL

The Board received a petition for review of the Department's denial of an individual residential builder license application received April 22, 2008. The Department denied the license on the basis of a lack of financial stability, as evidenced by a recent credit report. Mr. Powell addressed the Board.

MOTION: It was moved by Ms. Lane and Mr. August that, after careful consideration of the written petition and oral presentation, the Board that the grounds for previous denial are no longer considered a bar to licensure. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Haeussler abstained.

The Department concurred with the Board's decision.

Respondent shall make restitution in the form of repairs to the home identified in the Building Inspection Report, dated October 26, 2006, to the satisfaction of the Washtenaw County Building Department and according to the Michigan Residential Code violations cited in the Report, within ninety (90) days from the date of mailing of the Final Order.
- c. Failure to pay the fine within sixty (60) days of the date of mailing of the Final Order shall result in suspension or continued suspension of all licenses or registrations of Respondent (individual and/or corporate) or in the denial of any license renewal or future application for licensure until compliance is made with the terms of the stipulation.
- d. Failure to comply with the terms of the stipulation within ninety (90) days shall result in revocation of all licenses or registrations of Respondent (individual and/or corporate) or in the denial of any license renewal or future application for licensure until compliance is made with the terms of the stipulation.
