

Application for Waiver of Fundamentals of Engineering Examination

Recognizing the extraordinary education background achieved by an individual holding both a Bachelors of Science degree in engineering from an **ABET-EAC** (www.abet.org) (or an equivalent degree from a foreign university) **AND** a Doctorate degree in engineering from a school with an ABET-EAC (www.abet.org) accredited bachelors degree in the same engineering discipline as the PhD from a United States institution, the Board of Professional Engineers accepts these degrees as equivalent proof of knowledge of engineering fundamentals as that evidenced by successful completion of the engineering Fundamental's of Engineering (EIT/FE) examination. Individuals possessing both degrees may now become licensed as a professional engineer without writing the Fundamentals of Engineering (EIT/FE) examination. **All** licensing candidates, including those not taking the fundamentals examination, are required to pass the Principles and Practice Examination to become licensed as a professional engineer in the State of Michigan.

Prior to review of this request, an application for licensure must be filed with the Board Office. The application may be obtained at www.michigan.gov/commerciallicensing.com. In addition, you must order the Ph.D. transcript and have it sent directly from the University to the Board Office.

By completing the following information, you are requesting the Board Office to waive the Fundamentals of Engineering/EIT/FE examination based on your Ph.D. Degree:
