You will be receiving the license in the mail. Please review it for accuracy.

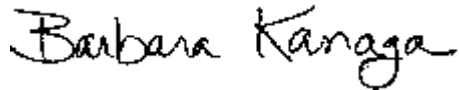

## DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following:

### **R 400.5102a      Staff training requirements.**

(6) The licensee shall assure that caregivers for infants and toddlers have training that includes information about safe sleep and shaken baby syndrome prior to caring for infants and toddlers.

No documentation was on file verifying that one of the infant caregivers had received the required safe sleep/shaken baby training prior to caring for the infants.

### **R 400.5103a      Lead caregiver qualifications; responsibilities.**

(6) A lead caregiver for infants and toddlers shall have 3

semester hours in infant/toddler development and care practices, from an accredited college or university, or 4.5 ceus in infant/toddler development and care practices. These hours or ceus may satisfy a portion of the requirements of subrule (5) of this rule.

Those caregivers who may work as lead caregivers in the infant/toddler areas had not yet completed the required semester hours or cues in infant/toddler development and care practices.

**R 400.5104            Staff.**

(3) A staff member shall provide the child care center with documentation from the Department of Human Services that he or she has not been named in a central registry case as the perpetrator of child abuse or child neglect before having contact with a child in care.

No documentation was on file verifying that one caregiver had completed the required DHS/CPS clearance prior to having contact with children in care.

**R 400.5104b            Health of staff and volunteers; report.**

(1) The center shall have on file a report, signed by a licensed physician, for each staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks. This report shall declare, to the best of the physician's knowledge, the physical capability of the staff member to perform the duties required. The report shall be signed not more than 6 months before, or 30 days after, the start of employment.

No physician signed medical statement was on file for one of the caregivers.

**R 400.5114            Information provided to parents.**

(1) A licensee shall develop a written information packet to be provided to each parent enrolling a child that includes, but is not limited to the following:

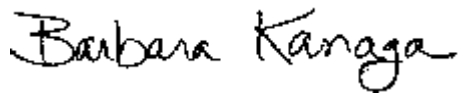
(g) Health care plan.

The center had not provided the parents with the information regarding how the center handles bodily fluids, sanitizes toys and other surfaces, and controls infections.

A corrective action plan was requested, received and approved on 09/18/2009. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

### III. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child day care center, effective 09/25/2009 through 09/24/2011.
