

I. INTRODUCTION

The information submitted herewith consists of a Brief in Support of Application by Ameritech Michigan for Provision of In-Region, InterLATA Services in Michigan (Supporting Brief), together with supporting Affidavits and attachments, in substantially the form that Ameritech intends to subsequently file them at the FCC. II. RELATED MATTERS

As provided in the May 15 Order, Ameritech Michigan is today serving copies of the public version of this filing in the form of a readable CD-ROM³ on all parties who have submitted a notice of interest in this proceeding. Ameritech Michigan attached a proposed Protective Agreement to the Notice of Intent to be executed by those parties who have a need to review the confidential portions of this filing. In response to concerns raised by some interested parties, on May 14, 2001, Ameritech served a revised proposed protective agreement on the parties of record. In accordance with the May 15 Order, Ameritech Michigan will continue to work with the parties in an attempt to reach a reasonable accommodation.
