

EDI Test Case Guidelines

Scenario 1	End user is migrating their existing phone service from the RBOC to McLeodUSA. There are no changes in the number of lines, directory listings are not changing, but it will be a coordinated hot cut.
Scenario 2	End user is migrating their existing phone service from the RBOC to McLeodUSA. They are changing the existing hunt group and some existing features. In addition they are changing the PIC/LPIC
Scenario 3	End user is migrating their existing phone service from the RBOC to McLeodUSA. They are removing the existing hunt group, changing existing directory listings and adding a complex listing.
Scenario 4	End user is migrating their existing phone service from the RBOC to McLeodUSA. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - adding a new line - adding a new hunt group - adding additional features - adding a directory listing - adding a non-pub - changing the routing to PSTN
Scenario 5	End user is setting up new service at 2 locations. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The 1 location has a line that remote call forwards to the second - Add a new hunt group - Add new features - Add directory listings - One line is non-pub
Scenario 6	A McLeod End user is splitting their account and moving the main TN to another location within the current co while main taining some lines at the current residence. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Changing the existing hunt group - adding a new hunt group for the new location - changing the directory listings
Scenario 7	A McLeod end user is moving their entire account within the current CO. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adding a hunt group - Changing the directory listings - Swapping a TN for a new one - Adding a DL for the new TN and Deleting the old TN's DL
Scenario 8	A McLeod end user is adding a new line. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Changing some of the existing features - Adding it to the hunt group - Adding a foreign listing - Adding a complex listing
Scenario 9	A McLeod end user is removing one of their lines. In addition they are doing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Removing the line from the hunt group - Removing the directory listings - Removing the caption
Scenario 10	A McLeod end user is disconnecting their account. Remove all lines, features, and directory.
