

**Ameritech Michigan**  
**Performance Remedy Plan Proposal**  
**Summary**

This document represents Ameritech's proposal for a performance assurance plan in accordance with the Michigan Public Service Commissions July 17, 2000 Order in Case No. U-11830 and the February 9, 2000 Order in Case No. U-12320. The plan documented here is the Texas remedy plan as modified for use in Michigan. It is a two-tiered plan, with Tier 1 liquidated damages paid to directly to CLECs and Tier 2 assessments paid to the state.

The FCC has accepted this plan in two separate venues. First, it is the same plan used in the calculation of remedies paid to the U.S. treasury (Tier 3). These remedies are paid based on a subset of thirty-six Texas measures, all of which are included in the set approved by the Michigan Commission. Tier-3 remedies were established as required by the SBC/Ameritech merger order. Second, the plan was a key component of the Texas section 271 application approved by the FCC this year.

Some of the new performance measurements, which are Michigan specific, have not yet been assigned to remedy groups for Tier 1 and Tier 2 assessments. Ameritech proposes a full review of the "High", "Medium", or "Low" Measurement Types by the Performance Measure Collaborative, to establish the level of remedies to be paid for these new measures in the initial 6-month review. The timing of this review will enable the parties to establish a basis of historical performance in Ameritech Michigan, on which to make these decisions.
