

STIPULATION

This Stipulation ("Stipulation") between SBC Telecommunications, Inc. ("SBC") and AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") is entered into effective as of February ~~27~~, 2000.

WHEREAS, by a letter dated November 23, 1999, AT&T, acting on behalf of itself, AT&T Communications of Indiana, Inc., AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., AT&T Communications of Ohio, Inc., AT&T Communications of Wisconsin, Inc., and the TCG entities for those four states, requested that Ameritech Michigan, Ameritech Indiana, Ameritech Ohio, and Ameritech Wisconsin negotiate interconnection agreements with AT&T pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1995 ("the Act");

WHEREAS, representatives of AT&T and representatives of Ameritech Michigan, Ameritech Indiana, Ameritech Ohio, and Ameritech Wisconsin subsequently met and communicated;

WHEREAS, SBC, acting on behalf of itself and Ameritech Indiana, Ameritech Michigan, Ameritech Ohio, and Ameritech Wisconsin, has requested additional time to prepare its proposal for negotiations.

NOW THEREFORE:

1. The dates upon which SBC received the requests from AT&T for negotiation of new interconnection agreements under Sections 251 and 252 of the Act ("Negotiation Requests") shall be deemed by the Parties to be as follows:

- a. Michigan – December 14, 1999;
- b. Wisconsin – December 21, 1999;
- c. Indiana – December 28, 1999;
- d. Ohio – January 4, 2000.

2. The 135th day after SBC received AT&T's Negotiation Requests shall be deemed by the Parties to be as follows:

- a. Michigan – April 27, 2000;
- b. Wisconsin – May 4, 2000;
- c. Indiana – May 11, 2000;
- d. Ohio – May 18, 2000.

3. The time period during which either Party may petition the Commission under Section 252(b)(1) to arbitrate any open issues in connection with such negotiations shall be:

- a. Michigan – commencing on April 27, 2000 and ending on May 22, 2000;
- b. Wisconsin – commencing on May 4, 2000 and ending on May 29, 2000;
- c. Indiana – commencing on May 11, 2000 and ending on June 5, 2000;
- d. Ohio – commencing on May 18, 2000 and ending on July 12, 2000.

4. The parties will execute new interconnection agreements as a result of the Negotiation Requests. The Ameritech interconnection agreements that were in effect with AT&T Communications of Indiana, Inc., AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., AT&T Communications of Ohio, Inc., AT&T Communications of Wisconsin, Inc., and the TCG entities for those four states as of December 31, 1999 shall remain in effect in accordance with their terms until new interconnection agreements are approved under Section 252 of the Act, notwithstanding any expiration dates or notices of termination.

5. Meetings and communications between the parties both prior to and subsequent to the date of this agreement shall be considered part of the interconnection negotiations for all purposes.

6. By March 6, 2000, AT&T will provide to SBC/Ameritech its proposed changes to the existing Michigan agreement in redlined electronic and paper format, for the remaining sections of the agreement that have not already been provided to SBC/Ameritech (such document, in its entirety, referred to as the "AT&T Proposed Agreement"). SBC/Ameritech will then review the AT&T Proposed Agreement and prepare a redline (or a document using some other like highlighting device) of the AT&T Proposed Agreement to indicate any (1) AT&T proposed changes which are acceptable to SBC/Ameritech and (2) changes SBC/Ameritech proposes to the AT&T Proposed Agreement (such document referred to as the "SBC/Ameritech Redline"). SBC/Ameritech shall provide AT&T an electronic copy and paper copy of the SBC/Ameritech Redline as soon as possible but in any event by March 27, 2000. Except for certain state specific issues (e.g., MTSS in Ohio or other state specific rules), the SBC/Ameritech Redline will constitute the SBC/Ameritech interconnection agreement proposal for and on behalf of Ameritech Michigan, Ameritech Indiana, Ameritech Wisconsin, and Ameritech Ohio.




