**AFFIDAVIT OF ALAN C. LUNCEFORD**

1. My name is Alan C. Lunceford. My business address is 12790 Merit Drive, Suite 200, Dallas, TX, 75251. I am employed by XO Communications, Inc. ("XO") as Senior Manager of DSL Provisioning. My job responsibilities include managing the process for DSL provisioning and installation.

2. I have been employed by XO since July 1997.

3. In order to successfully provision DSL, the customer who is ordering the service should be within 18,000 feet of the customer's service central office ("CO").

4. When XO orders loops from Ameritech to use in the provisioning of DSL, Ameritech sometimes cancels XO's DSL loop orders citing the following reason "LOOP MAKEUP INFORMATION NOT AVAILABLE." XO then asks Ameritech to provide the loop length for each such order that is rejected. Thus far, XO's efforts to receive a satisfactory explanation have proven unsuccessful.

5. XO is aware of other SBC affiliates providing the loop length information to XO affiliates in other states.


6. In many cases, XO has competitors who are providing DSL service to their customers who are just next door to the XO customer whose loop Ameritech has

rejected. In some instances, Ameritech is providing its own DSL service to some of those XO's customers who received a rejection. This causes significant questions regarding the legitimacy of Ameritech's rejection. If XO competitors and Ameritech are providing DSL service through Ameritech loops, then there is no basis for Ameritech's rejection.

7. Ameritech's actions place XO at a competitive disadvantage.
