April 21, 2005

Don discussed his and Marc's review of landfill gas projects and their potential. We reviewed the handout and discussed the difference of the potential at existing generation facilities.

Cogeneration discussion: Review of the DEQ data provided on steam / boilers used in the state.

Mike suggested we review the data of steam/ boilers installed before 1973 (energy crisis). These would probably be more efficient to replace with Cogen potential. Another criteria on gas-fired units would be less than 100,000lbs/hr should be deleted. Plus if operating less than 150psi should also be deleted. Lastly if greater than 900psi one assumes this unit is also generating currently.

Don will email everyone a Danish website with windmill design and efficiency. Don feels this is the approach that we should use for wind generation. We will discuss at the next meeting and conclude this approach at the next meeting.
