Catherine Wolfram and Meredith Fowlie will lead the discussion following up on their November presentation (via telephone). (Review their earlier PowerPoint presentation at http://www.dleg.state.mi.us/mpsc/electric/workgroups/lowincome/fowlie_wolfram.pdf)

- Topics to be covered include:
 - (1) Identifying income-eligible households. Our current strategy involves using census data and possibly working with a marketing firm. We would be very interested in any other ideas about how we might find current contact information for owner-occupied households at or below 200% of the poverty line.
 - (2) Identifying community action agencies willing and able to work with us. We need to better understand what will be involved in collecting data regarding which households are weatherized in 2010/2011, which weatherization measures are installed, etc. We do not want to burden these agencies with any additional work
 - (3) Securing access to household level electricity and natural gas consumption data. Initial conversations with Consumers Energy and some of the cooperatives have been encouraging, but we still need to work out the details of non-disclosure agreements and make sure that concerns about confidentiality are adequately addressed.
