ORDER

On July 19, 1996, Phillip Bridges, d/b/a Community Sewer Cleaners, filed a complaint against Ameritech Michigan.

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended by 1995 PA 216, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Phillip Bridges, d/b/a Community Sewer Cleaners, against Ameritech Michigan is dismissed with prejudice.
