OPINION AND ORDER

On May 7, 1999, Saurbier, Siegan & Sanfield, P.C., filed a complaint against AT&T Communica-
tions of Michigan, Inc., and MCI WorldCom regarding problems that it had experienced in trying to
change its telephone service provider. At a hearing on September 9, 1999, the complainant requested
that it be permitted to withdraw the complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.;

MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101)

et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101
et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Saurbier, Siegan & Sanfield, P.C., against
AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., and MCI WorldCom is dismissed without prejudice.
