**OPINION AND ORDER**

On June 30, 1999, GTEL Communications, L.L.C., (GTEL) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act (MTA), MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq., for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On September 28, 1999, the Commission granted the application. On July 27, 2000, GTEL filed an application to expand the scope of the

license. On November 20, 2000, the Commission issued an order approving the application. On March 20, 2001, GTEL indicated its intent to surrender the license.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACSR 460.17101 et seq.
- b. GTEL's license should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that GTEL Communications, L.L.C.'s license to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26; MSA 22.45.
