ORDER

On July 27, 1999, BroadStream Corporation filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan
Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq., for a license to
provide basic local exchange service. On October 28, 1999, the Commission granted the appli-
cation. On April 23, 2001, BroadStream indicated its intent to surrender the license.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.;
- MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101)

et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS,
R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The license granted to BroadStream should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license granted to BroadStream Corporation to
provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
