**ORDER**

On August 7, 2000, Clawson Container Company, Steel Tank & Fabricating Co., and IBC North America, Inc., filed a complaint against Ameritech Michigan. On November 30, 2000, the complainants filed a request to withdraw the complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Clawson Container Company, Steel Tank & Fabricating Co., and IBC North America, Inc., against Ameritech Michigan is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
