ORDER

On September 11, 2000, Waldorf Floors L.L.C. filed a complaint against Advantage Telecommunications Corp. On December 8, 2000, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Waldorf Floors L.L.C. against Advantage Telecommunications Corp. is dismissed without prejudice.
