ORDER

On December 1, 2000, LightBonding.com, Inc., (LightBonding) filed an application,
pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101)
et seq., for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On March 7, 2001, the Commission
granted the application. On June 8, 2001, LightBonding indicated its intent to surrender the
license.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.;
MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101)

et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The license granted to LightBonding should be rescinded.

c. LightBonding should surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. LightBonding.com, Inc.'s license to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

B. LightBonding.com, Inc., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26; MSA 22.45.
