**OPINION AND ORDER**

On February 5 and 6, 2001, Gene W. Hoekwater filed two complaints against MCI WorldCom Network Services, Inc., (WorldCom) and two complaints against Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) alleging unauthorized switches in service providers. The Commission Staff

(Staff) filed appearances in all four cases. On March 28, 2001, the complainant, the Staff, and Sprint filed a stipulation for dismissal of two of the complaints with prejudice. On April 2, 2001, the complainant, the Staff, and WorldCom filed stipulations for dismissal of the other two complaints with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaints should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaints of Gene W. Hoekwater against MCI WorldCom Network Services, Inc., and Sprint Communications Company L.P. are dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26; MSA 22.45.
