ORDER

On March 2, 2001, American Veterinary Laboratory, Inc., filed a complaint against Ameritech Michigan alleging delays in the installation of facilities. On April 10, 2001, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of American Veterinary Laboratory, Inc., against Ameritech Michigan is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
