ORDER

On June 1, 2001, City of Benton Harbor filed a complaint against AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., regarding a billing dispute. On October 18, 2001, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of City of Benton Harbor against AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., is dismissed without prejudice.
