ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

On February 25, 2002, the Commission issued an order requiring ServiSense.com, Inc., (ServiSense) to show cause why it should not be found in violation of the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 et seq., and Commission orders for failing to comply with tariff requirements. Since that time, ServiSense has resolved the concerns that the Commission Staff had previously attempted to bring to its attention and filed an acceptable tariff, which is now in effect.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. This docket should be closed.
