ORDER

On February 13, 1997, Great Lakes Comnet, f/k/a The Michigan Independent Network, Inc., (Great Lakes Comnet) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 et seq., for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On May 22, 1997, the Commission granted the application. On April 30, 2003, Great Lakes Comnet indicated its intent to surrender the license.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The license granted to Great Lakes Comnet should be rescinded.
- c. Great Lakes Comnet should surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The license of Great Lakes Comnet, f/k/a The Michigan Independent Network, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.
- B. Great Lakes Comnet, f/k/a The Michigan Independent Network, Inc., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
