ORDER

On July 17, 2002, TelNet Worldwide, Inc., filed a complaint against Verizon North Inc. and Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems, regarding a dispute about payments for reciprocal compensation. On December 11, 2002, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of TelNet Worldwide, Inc., against Verizon North Inc. and Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems, is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
