ORDER

On October 25, 2002, Frontier Communications of Michigan, Inc., (Frontier) filed an application requesting authority to expand its local calling areas and to increase its rates for basic local exchange service. In an order dated January 21, 2003, the Commission dismissed the application without prejudice. On February 3, 2003, Frontier filed a petition for rehearing requesting that the Commission reverse its dismissal and, instead, hold its ruling on the application in abeyance. On April 2, 2003, Frontier filed a request to withdraw its petition for rehearing.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. Frontier's petition for rehearing should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition for rehearing of Frontier Communications of Michigan, Inc., is dismissed.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
