**ORDER**

On November 2, 2004, SBC Michigan and Quick Communications, Inc., jointly filed an  
application for approval of a third amendment to their interconnection agreement.

On November 9, 2004, the applicants filed a request to withdraw their application.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; the  
Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 USC 151  
et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission’s Rules of Practice  
and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The application should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application filed by SBC Michigan and Quick Communications, Inc., is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
