ORDER

On April 7, 1998, NEXTLINK Michigan, Inc. (NEXTLINK), now XO Michigan, Inc.¹, filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service in the areas that were served by Ameritech

Michigan or GTE North Incorporated. On July 13, 1998, NEXTLINK received its license. On March 3, 2000 in Case No. U-12232 its license was expanded to include additional exchanges, and on January 21, 2003 in Case No. U-13617 its license was expanded to include all exchanges served by SBC, Verizon North Inc., and Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems.

On April 22, 2005, XO Michigan filed a letter surrendering the above-referenced license.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The license for XO Michigan to provide basic local exchange service should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of XO Michigan, Inc., f/k/a NEXTLINK Michigan, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
