**ORDER**

On November 3, 2000, Global Telelink Services, Inc. (GTS), filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On February 5, 2001, GTS received its license.

On April 5, 2005, the receiver for GTS filed a letter surrendering the above-referenced license.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

b. The license for GTS to provide basic local exchange service should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Global Telelink Services, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
