**ORDER**

On May 14, 2004, Frank Pruitt filed a complaint against SBC Michigan alleging unauthorized interrupted service in violation of the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*  
On May 5, 2005, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Frank Pruitt against SBC Michigan is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
