ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME FOR FILING DATA

On February 4, 2005, SBC Michigan (SBC) filed a petition for rehearing or reconsideration of one narrow aspect of the Commission's January 6, 2005 order in these matters. Specifically, SBC requested that the Commission reconsider the requirement imposed on SBC and the competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs) to submit reports on a quarterly basis regarding line counts and other information routinely tracked by the Commission Staff (Staff) on an annual basis. According to SBC, its systems cannot extract data for the end of a quarter until the middle of the following month. Additionally, SBC asserts that, as a publicly traded company, it would be improper to disclose confidential information, even under the terms of a protective order. Because

of these considerations, SBC requests that the Commission grant it and the CLECs a full month instead of approximately two weeks to provide the required data.

No one filed an objection to SBC's petition. Therefore, the Commission finds that the relief requested in SBC's February 4, 2005 petition should be granted.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

b. Ordering paragraph "E" of the Commission's January 6, 2005 order, which requires SBC and all CLECs affected by the order to submit reports to the Commission on a quarterly basis on line counts and other such competitive data that is routinely collected by the Staff on an annual basis, should be revised to provide that the initial required report should be filed May 2, 2005, with subsequent reports to be filed on August 1, 2005, November 1, 2005, and February 1, 2006.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph "E" of the Commission's January 6, 2005 order, which requires SBC Michigan and all competitive local exchange carriers affected by the order to submit reports to the Commission on a quarterly basis on line counts and other such competitive data that is currently collected by the Commission Staff on an annual basis, is hereby revised to provide that the initial required report shall be filed May 2, 2005, with the subsequent reports to be filed on August 1, 2005, November 1, 2005, and February 1, 2006.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
