ORDER

On February 8, 2005, Dennis Engels, d/b/a Richard Engels Jewelers, Inc., filed a complaint against AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., alleging claims based on false, misleading, and deceptive statements in violation of the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.* On May 5, 2005, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Dennis Engels, d/b/a Richard Engels Jewelers, Inc., against AT&T Communications of Michigan, Inc., is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
