OPINION AND ORDER

In an order issued on February 22, 2000, the Commission granted Mpower Communications Corp., f/k/a MGC Communications, Inc. (Mpower), a license to provide basic local exchange service in all exchanges and zones currently served by Ameritech Michigan, GTE North Incorporated, and GTE Systems pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*

On May 25, 2006, Mpower submitted a request for authority to immediately surrender its license. In so doing, Mpower represents that it has no customers or facilities providing regulated telecommunications services in Michigan.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

b. Mpower's request for authority to surrender its license to provide basic local exchange service in Michigan should be granted.

c. Mpower should surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The license of Mpower Communications Corp., f/k/a MGC Communications, Inc., is rescinded.

B. Mpower Communications Corp., f/k/a MGC Communications, Inc., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12).
