ORDER

On March 30, 2001, New Access Communications LLC (New Access) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On July 11, 2001, the Commission granted the application. On August 20, 2007, New Access indicated its intent to surrender the license. New Access states that it ceased to provide services to customers in Michigan on March 1, 2007.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 *et seq.*

- b. The license granted to New Access should be rescinded.
- c. New Access should surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The license of New Access Communications LLC to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.
- B. New Access Communications LLC shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12).
