ORDER

On June 9, 2000, C2C Fiber of Michigan, Inc. (C2C Fiber), filed an application, under the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On September 25, 2000, the Commission granted the application. On March 31, 2008, C2C Fiber informed the Commission of its intent to surrender the license. C2C Fiber states that it has no customers in Michigan.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The license of C2C Fiber of Michigan, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

B. C2C Fiber of Michigan, Inc., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
