ORDER

On November 17, 2000, Corvus, Inc. (Corvus), filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service. On March 7, 2001, the Commission granted the application. On April 10, 2008, Corvus informed the Commission of its intent to surrender the license. Corvus states that it ceased operations in Michigan as of March 31, 2008. Corvus has informed the Commission Staff that it no longer has customers in Michigan.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The license of Corvus, Inc., to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

B. Corvus, Inc., shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
