**ORDER**

On June 18, 2008, AT&T Michigan (f/k/a Ameritech Michigan) and NOW Communications, Inc. (NOW), filed a joint application requesting approval of a sixth amendment to the interconnection agreement between the parties approved by the Commission on February 5, 2001. By letter dated June 20, 2008, the Commission's Telecommunications Division informed NOW that it is not in the public interest to grant the application because the company is no longer registered with the Department of Labor and Economic Growth to do business in Michigan, and is not registered with the Intrastate Telecommunications Service Provider Database. *See*, 47 USC 252(e)(2)(A)(ii). The June 20 letter informed NOW that the application would be held in abeyance until proper registration is established.

Proper registration has not been established and the Commission finds that the application should be dismissed for lack of progress, without prejudice to filing a new application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the June 18, 2008 application filed by AT&T Michigan and NOW Communications, Inc., for a sixth amendment to an interconnection agreement is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court pursuant to 47 USC 252(e)(6).
