**ORDER**

On July 14, 2009, MISS DIG System, Inc., filed a complaint against AT&T Michigan. On  
September 25, 2009, the complainant filed a stipulation to dismiss the complaint with prejudice.  
On September 29, 2009, the Commission Staff filed a statement of non-objection to the  
stipulation. The Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice. All  
pending motions or applications filed in the proceeding are now moot.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of MISS DIG System, Inc., against  
AT&T Michigan is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
