**ORDER**

On September 11, 2009, Michigan Access, Inc. (Michigan Access) filed an application, pursuant to Section 214(e)(2) of the federal Communications Act of 1934, 47 USC § 214(e)(2), for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for purposes of universal service fund (USF) support. On January 21, 2010, Michigan Access filed a revised application to outline the federal USF support that is sought.

On August 22, 2006, in Case No. U-14896, Michigan Access was granted a permanent license to provide basic local exchange service throughout the state of Michigan. Michigan Access requests that the Commission enter an order designating it as an ETC, for purposes of High Cost and Lifeline/Link-up, in the wire centers listed in Exhibit E to the January 21, 2010 revised application.

After reviewing Michigan Access' application, the Commission finds that it should be granted because the Commission is persuaded that ETC designation for Michigan Access promotes the availability of universal service and is in the public interest. The application for ETC designation is granted on condition that Michigan Access comply with enhanced service requirements, as required by the FCC Report and Order 05-46, CC Docket 96-45, and the Commission's October 18, 2005 order in Case No. U-14530. This approval is for the remainder of 2010. Michigan Access will be required to re-apply to the Commission for ETC designation for 2011, and in following years, to retain its ETC designation.

Moreover, the Commission concludes, as it did in its November 20, 2001 order in Case No. U-13145, that it need not solicit comment, which would only further delay action on the application.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the application filed by Michigan Access, Inc., for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier for purposes of universal service fund support in the wire centers listed on Exhibit E to the January 21, 2010 application is granted.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
