ORDER

On September 28, 2010, Midwestern Telecommunications, Inc., (Midwestern) filed a petition, pursuant to 47 USC 214(e), for *ex parte* clarification of its designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for purposes of universal service fund support throughout its licensed service area or for designation as an ETC for its wireless service. On December 29, 2011, Midwestern filed a request to withdraw the application without prejudice. The Commission finds that the application should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that Midwestern Telecommunications, Inc.'s, application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12).
