ORDER ADOPTING RULES

In the December 20, 1996 order in this docket, the Commission commenced a rulemaking to revise Rule 3 of its rules governing electrical supply and communication lines and associated equipment, 1991 AACCS, R 460.813. Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, notice of a public hearing was issued, a hearing was conducted on March 4, 1997, and a period for making written comments was provided. No comments or suggestions proposing changes were received.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; MSA 22.151 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; MSA 22.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; MSA 22.13(1) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The requirements of Sections 41 and 42 of the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, as amended, MCL 24.241; MSA 3.560(141) and MCL 24.242; MSA 3.560(142), have been satisfied. Adequate notice and opportunity for participation by interested persons have been provided.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the proposed rule revising Rule 3 of the Commission's rules governing electrical supply and communication lines and associated equipment, as set forth in Exhibit A, is adopted and shall be submitted to the Legislative Service Bureau and the Office of Regulatory Reform for their approval in accordance with MCL 24.245; MSA 3.560(145) and Executive Order 1995-6.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
