ORDER

On July 15, 1998, Upper Peninsula Power Company filed an application to reopen the proceedings and to establish a revised power supply cost recovery (PSCR) plan and factors for its integrated system during 1998.

On September 22, 1998, the applicant requested to withdraw its application for a revised PSCR plan without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; MSA 22.151 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; MSA 22.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; MSA 22.13(1) et seq.; 1982 PA 304, as amended, MCL 460.6h et seq.;

MSA 22.13(6h) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The application should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application filed by Upper Peninsular Power Company on July 15, 1998 is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
