



category of power supplier, an alternative electric supplier, that is not a public utility. On July 19, 2000, Nordic filed a request to withdraw these applications.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; MSA 22.151 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; MSA 22.1 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; MSA 22.13(1) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101) et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The applications should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the applications of Nordic Electric, L.L.C., for approval of power purchase agreements are dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
