

“Adopt and issue minute dated March 29, 2001 requesting the Attorney General to intervene on behalf of the Michigan Public Service Commission before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. RT01-88-000, a filing by Ameren Corporation (Ameren), on behalf of Union Electric Company and Central Illinois Public Service Company; American Electric Power Service Corporation, on behalf of Appalachian Power Company, Columbus Southern Power Company, Indiana Michigan Power Company, Kentucky Power Company, Kingsport Power Company, Ohio Power Company, and Wheeling Power Company; Consumers Energy Company; Exelon Corporation, on behalf of Commonwealth Edison Company and Commonwealth Edison Company of Indiana, Inc. (ComEd); FirstEnergy Corp., on behalf of American Transmission Systems, Inc., The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Ohio Edison Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and The Toledo Edison Company; Illinois Power Company; The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L); The Detroit Edison Company; and Virginia Electric and Power Company (collectively, the Alliance Companies). In this filing, the Alliance Companies request approval of their Order 2000 compliance filing, amendments to the Alliance agreement, and requests by Ameren, Com Ed, Illinois Power, and DP&L to transfer ownership and control of their transmission facilities to the Alliance RTO.”
