AMENDATORY ORDER

On August 20, 2002, the Commission issued an order approving low-income energy efficiency grants from the Low-Income and Energy Efficiency Fund created by Section 10d(6) of the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, MCL 460.10d(6). The order enumerated six of the grants, but omitted the seventh. The Commission therefore amends the order to reflect the following grant:

- Washtenaw Affordable Housing Corporation - \$26,000 for an energy efficiency retrofit of a low-income apartment building and enhancement of residents' conservation awareness.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as

amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACCS, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. The August 20, 2002 order should be amended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the August 20, 2002 order is amended to reflect the following grant:

- Washtenaw Affordable Housing Corporation - \$26,000 for an energy efficiency retrofit of a low-income apartment building and enhancement of residents' conservation awareness.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
