ORDER

On May 17, 2002, Charles V. and Rose Marie Russo filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company regarding a billing dispute. On July 26, 2002, the complainants filed a request to withdraw the complaint without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACRS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Charles V. and Rose Marie Russo against The Detroit Edison Company is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
