**OPINION AND ORDER**

On January 22, 2002, the Commission granted Cook Inlet Power, LP, (Cook) a license as an alternative electric supplier pursuant to the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, 2000 PA 141 (Act 141), MCL 460.10 et seq.

By letter dated October 25, 2002, Cook submitted a request for authority to surrender its license.

On November 8, 2002, Cook indicated that its request to surrender its license should be postponed.

Having received no subsequent written confirmation of Cook's intention regarding its October 25, 2002 request to surrender its license, the Commission finds that Cook's request to surrender its license should be dismissed for lack of prosecution and that this docket should be closed without prejudice to Cook's ability to resubmit its request to surrender its license in the

future should it desire to do so. The Commission will continue to review Cook's "accessibility to the commission, to consumers and to electric utilities in this state" as required by Section 10a(2) of Act 141.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.

b. Cook's request to surrender its license as an alternative electric supplier should be dismissed.

c. This docket should be closed without prejudice to the resubmission by Cook of another request to surrender its license as an alternative electric supplier.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The October 25, 2002 request filed by Cook Inlet Power, LP, to surrender its license as an alternative electric supplier is dismissed.

B. This docket is closed without prejudice to the resubmission by Cook Inlet Power, LP, of another request to surrender its license as an alternative electric supplier.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26.
