ORDER

On September 6, 2002, James Glassford filed a complaint against Consumers Energy Company regarding a billing dispute. On November 6, 2002, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint without prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of James Glassford against Consumers Energy Company is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
