**ORDER**

On September 13, 2002, Prestige Development Company, LLC, (Prestige) filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company.

On July 22, 2003, Prestige requested permission to withdraw its complaint.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1909 PA 106, as amended, MCL 460.551 et seq.; 1919 PA 419, as amended, MCL 460.51 et seq.; 1939 PA 3, as amended, MCL 460.1 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. Prestige's request to withdraw its complaint should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request filed by Prestige Development Company, LLC, to withdraw its complaint against The Detroit Edison Company is granted.
